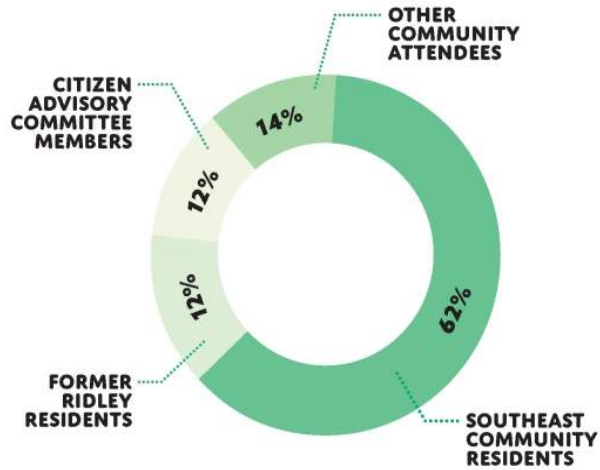


WHAT WE HEARD – WRT



WHO PARTICIPATED?



IN TOOLS FOR PLACEMAKING

PLAYSPACES

Participants favored colorful playspaces with play equipment on smooth surfaces for kids to run and bike as well as natural elements, such as trees and boulders, for kids to explore and cool off.



PLAYFUL INSTALLATION

Inter-generational and playful installations that offer more than one function was preferred.



COMFORT AREAS

Participants were least drawn to the precedent images of comfort areas.



SIGNAGE & WAYFINDING

Pavement wayfinding marking was most favored, followed by a conventional sign equipped with diverse information including a map.



STORMWATER MANAGEMENT

Participants preferred stormwater features in a park-like setting with natural elements, such as boulders, plants, and water, where kids can play and the community can gather all year around.



ENVIRONMENTAL GRAPHICS

Sculptural elements as well as artistic expressions on surfaces, such as pavements and walls, were preferred.



PROGRAMING & ACTIVITIES

Participants were most drawn to programming & activities amongst all the placemaking elements presented. Large-scale flexible lawns and plazas that can serve diverse types of year-around events were highly desired.



URBAN ORCHARDS & GARDENS

Community gardens with welcoming amenities, such as linear benches and string lights, were favored. Community gardens are desired as long as they can be maintained properly by volunteer groups.

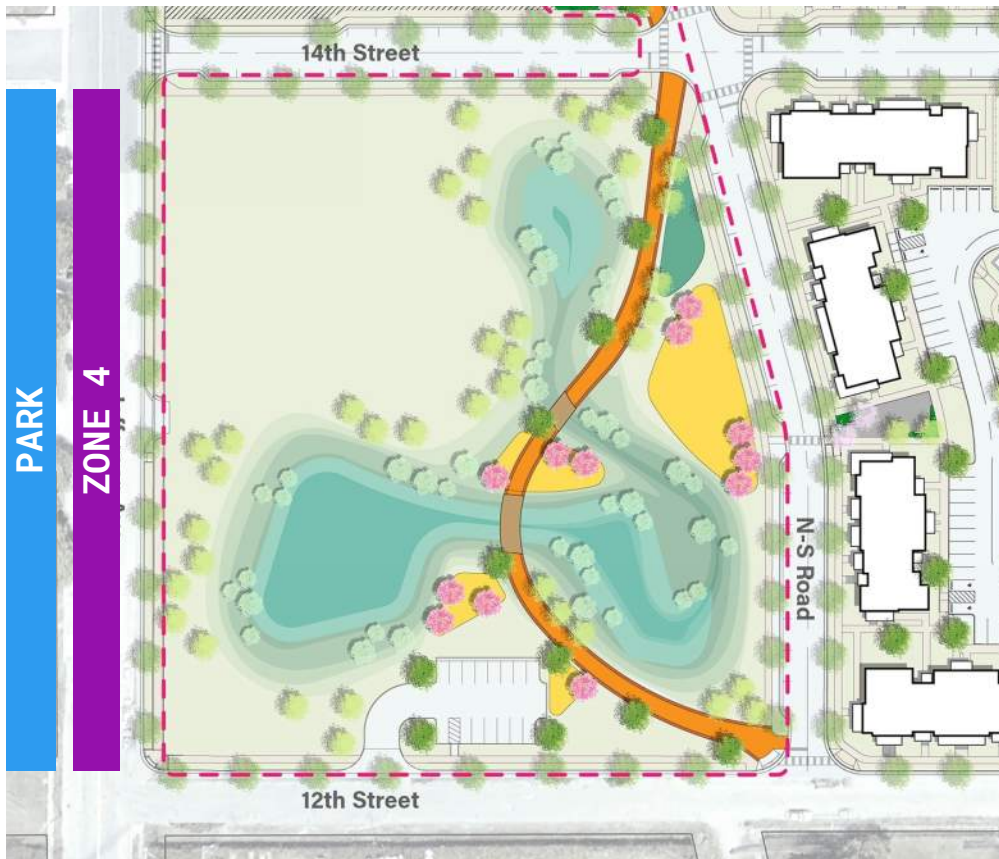


